AGM & APPOINTMENTS

1. Volunteer Trustees/Directors of the Charity are appointed each year at the AGM and are usually high-level business professionals and/or academics with a background in club swimming who meet up to 4 times a year.

TRUSTEES AND DIRECTOR

1. **Trustees and Directors have overall responsibility for:**
2. Although the Trustees and Directors are not involved in the day-to-day management of the business, they may exercise all the powers of the Charity unless they are subject to any restrictions imposed by the Companies Act, the Articles or any special resolution; and 11.22.2.
 - (a) carrying out the purpose of the Charity for the public benefit
 - (b) ensuring compliance with the Articles, the requirements of Swim England and the law;
 - (c) acting in the Charity's best interests;
 - (d) managing the resources of the Charity responsibly;
 - (e) ensuring the Charity is accountable; and
 - (f) ensuring that the accounts of the Charity for each financial year be independently examined, such independent examiner or auditor to be appointed by the members in a general meeting.
